

SCHOOL PROGRAM – FAMILY LIFE EDUCATION

POLICY

LEGAL REF: EA 85 (j), 176

1. Parents have the primary and continuing responsibility for providing family life education.
2. The school must provide a supportive role to parents in family life education. In this role opportunities to participate in the family life education program must be extended to all students.

BOARD APPROVED: June 28, 1982

REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

1. The family life education program shall be considered as a regular component of the instructional program.
2. The family life education program shall be approved by the designated Superintendent of Education.
3. A subcommittee of the Home and School Executive shall be established in order to facilitate family life education in the school.
4. The membership of the subcommittee shall be comprised of the principal, three parents (representative of the varying grade levels), and one to three teachers.
5. The committee shall be a liaison between the home and the school and have as its primary function to communicate with parents information pertaining to the family life program that is being taught in the school. The committee shall meet at least once annually.
6. All teachers involved in teaching family life education shall participate in family life education inservice.
