February 15 application deadline

In the USask calendar, February 15 is a key application deadline. It is the deadline for entering students to apply for admission to any program to be eligible to apply for USask's broad range of scholarships and bursaries, the Competitive Entrance Awards, valued between \$500-\$32,000.

It is also the deadline to apply for admission to the following programs for the 2021 Fall Term:

- Bachelor of Education, including the new Language Teacher Education program
- Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology
- Combined Bachelor of Education/Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology

For international students, February 15 is the deadline to apply for admission to be eligible for consideration or to apply for international student awards.

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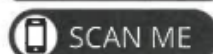
