#MarchOutRacism Workshops.

The Multicultural Council of Saskatchewan is holding four **workshops** to help create more welcoming and inclusive communities. The goal would to make racism disappear. In these workshops, you will learn about racism, its's impact and what you can do about it! The workshops will take place virtually. The **first session** will take place in the **morning of March 9th** and in the **afternoon of March 10th** (one day total). In this session, students will take part in a simulation and then debrief in small groups and share insights gained. The **second session** will take place **March 16th in the morning** and conclude **March 17th in the afternoon** (again, one day total). This session will involve watching "Ripples of Racism" videos and then engage in breakout small group discussions. You will then share what you have learned by presenting to Global Bridges so that those who were not able to take part can learn from your experience.

These workshops are open to all students. You do not have to be part of Global Bridges although you are encouraged to join and help plan our upcoming events!
