Shulich Scholarship application forms are now available on the bulletin board in Student Services. Schulich Leader Scholarships are Canada's most coveted undergraduate STEM scholarships. Fifty are awarded to entrepreneurial-minded high school graduates enrolling in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math program at 20 partner universities across Canada.
