**Saskatchewan Pulse Growers (SPG) is once again giving out five, \$5,000 scholarships in 2019.** To be eligible for a scholarship, students must complete Grade 12 this year and go on to attend a Saskatchewan-based post-secondary program full-time this fall, in a program associated with the agriculture industry. The student or student's parent(s) must also be registered Saskatchewan pulse growers (i.e. they have sold Saskatchewan-grown pulses in the last two years). Application form in Student Services. Application deadline **May 3, 2019.**
