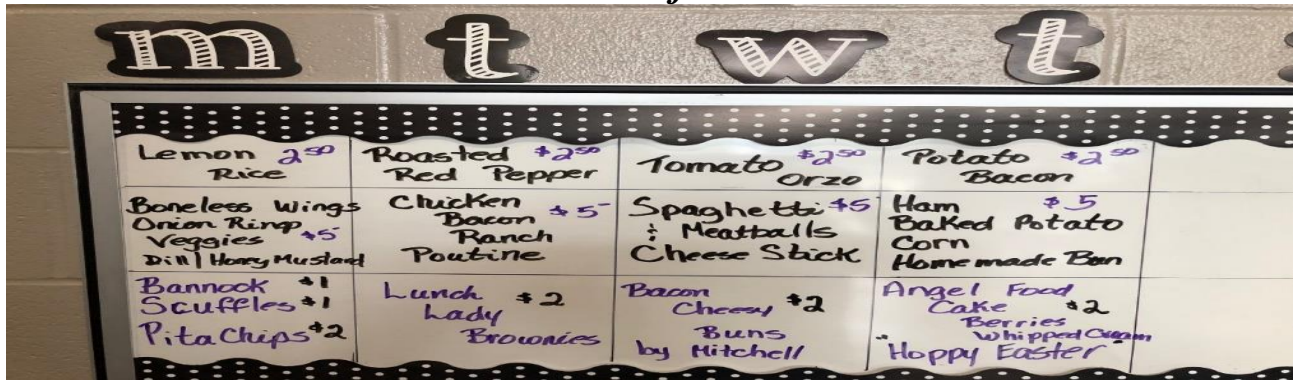

\*Yearbook: Complete all assigned pages. Meeting Friday May 3rd at lunch in room 214. Mandatory work session after school Tuesday May 14th.

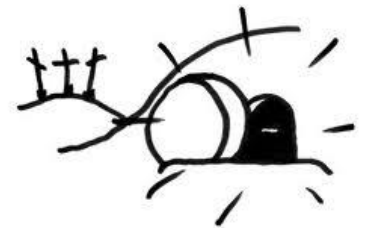

**Saskatchewan Pulse Growers (SPG) is once again giving out five, \$5,000 scholarships in 2019.** To be eligible for a scholarship, students must complete Grade 12 this year and go on to attend a Saskatchewan-based post-secondary program full-time this fall, in a program associated with the agriculture industry.
