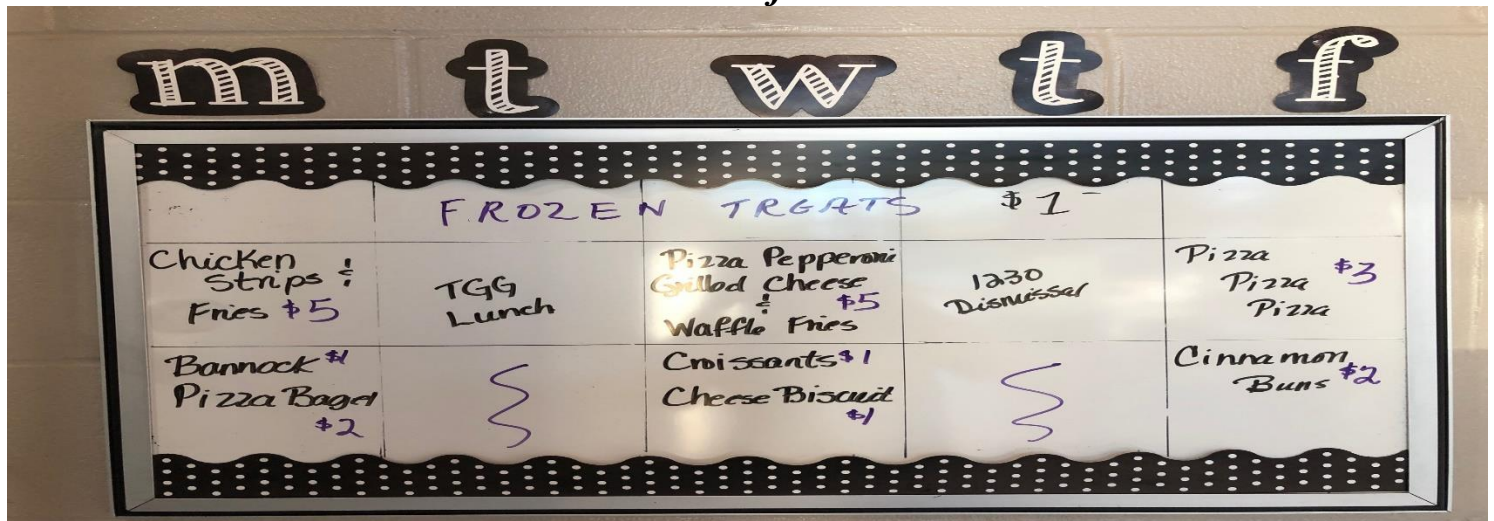


*This Week's Cafeteria Menu****Today and New Notices**
