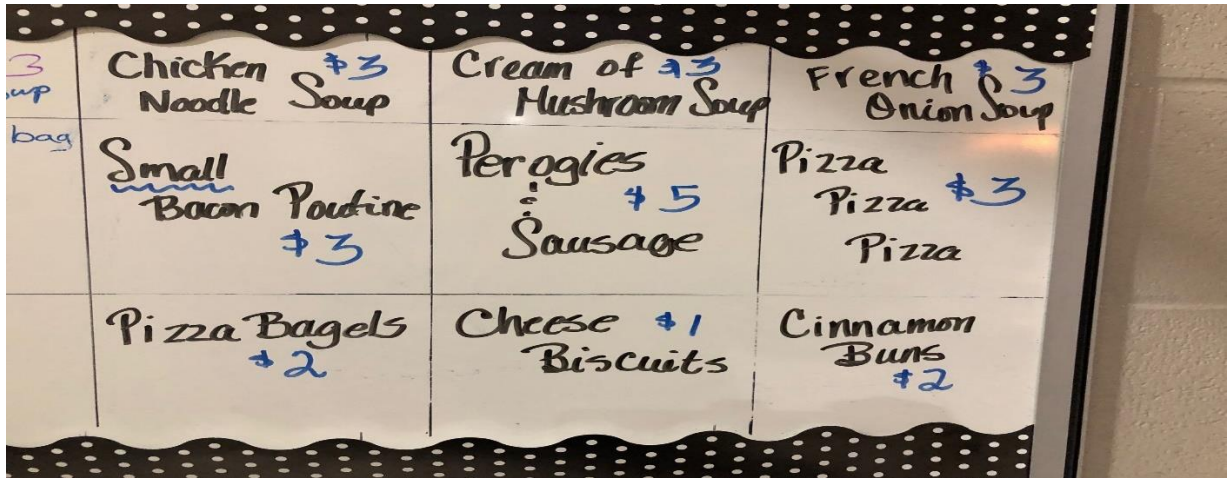




This Week's Cafeteria Menu
