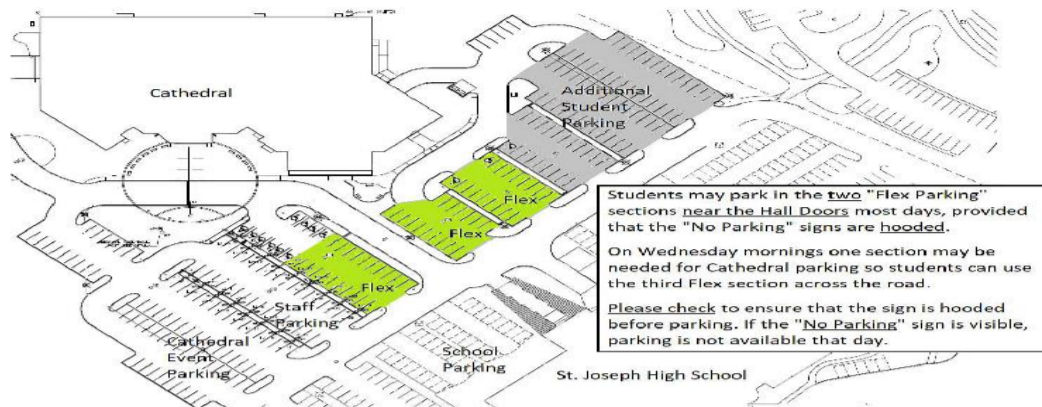

**U of S Math Placement Test (MPT)** Grade 12 students who are interested in writing in May or June please stop by Student Services and let us know. The U of S may be offering earlier MPT writing dates if there is enough student interest. **The MPT is :** open to students that have been accepted to the U of S and is primarily intended for those who need to take one of the following introductory calculus courses: Math 110/121/123/125. Math 110 is for students in the College of Arts and Science, 121 is for Edwards School of Business students, 123 is for Engineering students, and 125 is for students enrolled in a health-science related discipline. **Saskatchewan Pulse Growers (SPG) is once again giving out five, \$5,000 scholarships in 2018.** To be eligible for a scholarship, students must complete Grade 12 this year and go on to attend a Saskatchewan-based post-secondary program full-time this fall, in a program associated with the agriculture industry.
