The Philippine Eagle is the national bird of the Philippines, the home country of St. Lorenzo Ruiz. Eagles are beautiful, brave, determined, unwavering birds, known for soaring to great heights. They also have keen vision and are very nurturing to their young. The eagle, as a sign of strength, is found in the Old Testament of the Bible numerous times.

Our first image was basic and did not include the words. It was our "vision" and the paths leading to/from the cross connect to our school vision statement "we will persevere in our learning **journey**, in order to make a difference in our world." The paths stretching out in all directions. It was then we got the idea to add some of the words from our school mission statement to the logo, "One **family**, rooted in **faith**, **learning** together" and they appear **together** on the **one** image of the eagle, at the base (**root**) of the image.

Attendance System - Safe Arrival

This system is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, to make it convenient for you to report future absences.

It is important to sign-up using the email address you have provided the school. You will also be asked to set-up the phone numbers you would like calls to be sent to, which is found under preferences on mobile app and website.
