Kindergarten Registration for the 2021-2022 school year opened in January. Children who will be 5 years old or before January 31, 2022 (birthday January 31, 2017) can register for Kindergarten by contacting the school or visiting [www.gscs.ca/kindergarten](http://www.gscs.ca/kindergarten).

### Daily Screening for COVID-19

It is imperative that parents and guardians please screen their children before sending them to school. If a student has any one of the symptoms listed on the Daily Screening Questionnaire that is attached at the end of the newsletter, we ask that the child please remain at home until symptom-free for 48 hours. Thank you for your cooperation and assistance with this matter.

## Forty-Eight Hour Self Isolation

Should a student be sent home experiencing any of the Covid-19 symptoms on the Daily Screening Questionnaire, they must self-isolate at home for 48 hours (beginning the next day) and be symptom free before they return to school. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.



If you have answered "Yes" to any of the above questions, please **DO NOT** enter the school at this time. You should stay home and call 811 for directions.

If you have answered "No" to all the above questions, you may attend school.

The initial purpose of the 50-day Easter season was to continue the faith formation of these new Christians.
